

## Pupil Premium Statement 2015-2016

St Monica's Catholic High School and 6<sup>th</sup> Form Centre receives a Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) for every Looked after Child and for any child in receipt of free school meals in the past six years. The PPG has allowed us to fully fund, as well as subsidise particular areas in school with a view to providing our disadvantaged youngsters with the opportunities needed for them to reach their full potential.

in 2015/2016 the additional funding provided to St Monica's in the form of the PPG amounted to £196,285.

The PPG has helped the school to provide:

- Employment of a Pastoral and Assistant Pastoral Manager, along with an Inclusion Support Officer who help to manage the day to day welfare and pastoral care of students at St Monica's so that students are able to access the curriculum and make progress despite their backgrounds.
- Employment of an in school counselling service to support those students who may be falling behind due to their complex emotional needs.
- Additional teaching staff in order to ensure intervention is put in place in the form of small group teaching, or in some cases, one to one support.
- An Internal Exclusion Unit (TRUST) which is used to support students who display challenging behaviour in school.
- A PP trip account which helps to ensure that our disadvantaged students do not miss out on cultural opportunities owing to financial constraints.
- Peripatetic music lessons (provided by Bury Music Service) for our PP students so that they are able to access the same opportunities as their peers.
- A PP bidding system available to staff so that they are able to bid for money for activities/resources that they feel would benefit our PP students. This bidding system funds such things as: revision guides, revision resources, books, P.E kit/equipment etc.
- A range of mentoring/engagement activities which target PP students in particular and help to build resilience, aspirations, revision skills.
