<b>Lesson</b>	<b>Objectives</b>
1. What are stereotypical careers?	To gain knowledge of different jobs, their qualifications and to develop the skill of explaining future ideas
2. Are jobs like Russian Dolls?	To gain familiarity with different job titles and their descriptions, familiarity with one work place and its associated jobs and investigate different job opportunities available in general
3. What can I do with my options after School?	To learn about different subject options which can be chosen in year 9 and to understand the relationship between school subjects and different careers and to explain the importance of their options choices for their future careers
4. Options Advice Column	To research the agencies who help with making options choices.  To learn strategies to relieve the stress of making option choices and to find out the importance of at least one subject they might choose for options
