Types of Questions you might answer at GCSE

AO1 and AO2 Knowledge and Understanding: Describe questions, Explain questions (these focus on causes, impact) Essay questions (which ask you to make your own judgement)

AO3 How useful is the source? Compare the usefulness of these sources?

AO4 How convincing is this interpretation? Which interpretation is more convincing?
