- **What are the key standards you think the school should uphold:**

a. In lessons

Teachers to uphold the standards

Don't send people out – they walk away

No shouting out

Disciplined more – not just warned and warned

b. Out of lessons

No messing about

Not spraying water

No littering

Think about uniform/behaviour/equipment/homework

- **What helps to promote good behaviour in lessons and around school?**
 - Not just working from a text book**
 - Being rewarded**
 - Teachers to interact with students**
 - When teachers speak make it relevant/listen to what we say and answer not in a vague way**
 - Increase cctv**

- **How should we let pupils know about the rules and the agreed consequences? - Show pupils the proposed flow chart for behaviour – feedback?**

Not in assembly – not enough attention paid

Not posters in form – nobody looks

Students who have behaviour incidents should be told separately

Be told every day over and over – like we were about the new school day
