At St Monica's, the purpose of our assessment system is to inform and improve the quality of teaching and learning across the whole school. The assessment cycle enables us to collect data at key points throughout the year which tracks pupil progress. We will quality assure the process throughout, to ensure that data is accurate, clear and meaningful when reporting to pupils, parents, members of the IEB and other external agencies when appropriate. Pupils are given meaningful and timely feedback on their assessments so that they understand how to move forward with their learning.
