Famous person Portrait project should include ...

AO1

Research of portrait art inspired images & inspirations/Influences that you could look at to help you within your own design:

Your work should include :-

- 2 x Portrait Artist research sheets – these will be artists who inspire you!
- 1 x Mood board based on your chosen Famous person

Written work :-

Mood board – Explain what you find interesting about that person – why do they inspire you? How do you hope to capture this within your work?

Artist research sheets –

Talk about why their work inspires you – what do you find interesting? Talk about colours, shapes, composition, style, tone, message. Give some information about how they became an artist, what are they inspired by? Which materials do they use? Where can you see their work? Which areas of their work will you try to explore within your own ideas & why?
